Hisao's Story...

"Greetings: You are hereby ordered for induction into the Armed Forces of the United States, and to report... on December 7, 1965."

Basic Training and Advanced Individual Training was with the 4th Infantry

Division in Fort Lewis, Washington. In the Fall of 1966, the 30,000 men of the 4th Infantry Division were deployed to Vietnam. In May of 1967 in the Central Highlands near the Cambodian border, as part of the 1st Brigade of the 4th Infantry Division, we fought in the infamous Nine Days in May. Battling two North Vietnamese Army regiments for nine consecutive days, the 1st Brigade earned the coveted Presidential Unit Citation.
